

TRANSFER OF CREDIT FROM OTHER INSTITUTIONS

Thomas Aquinas College's program of studies is an integrated liberal arts program based primarily on a study of the Great Books. Individual disciplines are not studied in isolation from the rest; rather, the relation, order and integration of the various disciplines are themselves objects of study. Due to the unique nature of the program, all students follow the same course of studies. The curriculum of Thomas Aquinas College can be characterized as the equivalent of an integrated course in education. As a consequence, Thomas Aquinas College admits only those who intend to enter as freshmen, and credits do not transfer to Thomas Aquinas College from other institutions.
